**Suggestions for younger girls can earn the Friendly patch:**

When they have decided how they feel, it's a great idea to talk over each scenario as a troop. Challenge your girls to think about if their friends are true friends or more of frenemies.

## Suggestions for Community Friendliness:

The only way to reduce the number of mean girls in your community is if more girls decide to be a true friend regardless of what others do.
