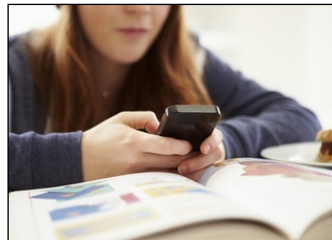
It's OK to post embarrassing photos of someone as long as everyone will think's funny.
